# Interlink Volunteers

Office hours are 9 am to 4 pm, Monday thru Thursday.

We provide these services, and offer volunteer opportunities in each of these areas:

...**local transportation** within Nez Perce County, Idaho and Asotin County, WA. Please, we ask 48 hours notice to schedule our volunteers. Rides are provided for medical appointments, shopping, personal care and to meet other needs.

...**construction of Wheelchair Ramps**. Following a home assessment, it takes generally 6-8 weeks for us to complete a ramp project. Materials are provided at no cost to the recipient. We are a registered contractor with the State of Washington Area Agency on Aging (Aging and Long Term Care).

...**yard work**. Following a home assessment, we are able to perform general yard work. This includes raking leaves, pulling weeds, some trimming of trees and bushes, and hauling yard waste. Volunteers will provide their own yard tools. On occasion, these situations are good opportunities for group projects

...**home repair**. Following a home assessment, our volunteer handyman can generally install a grab bar, replace a window or screen, make small plumbing repairs, and complete similar small home repairs.

...**moving service**. An assessment is necessary for these situations. We ask for as much time and flexibility as possible to schedule this opportunity.

We encourage you to give us a call. We are a partner agency of the Twin County United Way and work closely with many other community service agencies.
